Frequently Asked Questions

How do I register?

Individuals and teams can register online at bit.ly/CorinthGAC. Registration closes April 10, 2026. To register as a team, please make sure each team member has an account on our volunteer site, cityofcorinth.galaxydigital.com.

I missed online registration. Can I still participate in the Great American Cleanup?

Those who missed registration and are still interested in volunteering are invited to come to the Commons at Agora, 3280 Agora Way, at 8 a.m. on event day to receive a site assignment and cleanup supplies. Please note that due to limited quantities, walk-up volunteers are not guaranteed an event T-shirt.

When will I know my cleanup location?

Cleanup locations will be emailed to registrants after registration closes on April 10. Please allow staff 3-4 days to process all registrations.

When and where do I pick up all of my supplies?

Supply pick-up for registered volunteers is Monday, April 20, at Traveler's Cantina, 1400 N Corinth St #103 (4-8 p.m.) and on Tuesday, April 21, and Wednesday, April 22 (8 a.m. – 4 p.m.) at the Parks and Recreation Office, 3101 S. Garrison Rd.

What supplies will I receive?

KCB provides volunteers with free trash bags, recycling bags, disposable gloves, litter tongs, and event T-shirts. Supplies and event T-shirts are first-come, first-served. Due to limited shirt quantities, event T-shirts are not guaranteed to all registered volunteers. Arrive early in the week to secure your group's shirts.

I'm registered and have my supplies. Do I need to come by Agora before I go to my cleanup location?

No, if you've received your supplies, you can go directly to your cleanup site to begin your cleanup.

Where do I take my trash bags after event day?

After completing your cleanup on Saturday and filling out your cleanup report form, dispose of your collected trash and recycling responsibly by transporting it to the Denton County lot, 3305 Corinth Pkwy. We will offer drive-thru bag drop-off.

Are there any littered items that I should not pick up?

Please do not pick up any hazardous waste or large/heavy items that would be unsafe to carry. Examples include mattresses, furniture, dead animals, needles, and broken window panes. Please report these items by calling KCB at (940) 498-7547.

When and where is the volunteer party?

After completing your cleanup on Saturday, please join us for a volunteer party celebrating all your hard work! It is Saturday, April 25, from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the Commons at Agora, 3280 Agora Way. The party includes free lunch, an obstacle course, music, event giveaways, and special awards.

Can KCB staff sign this?

Do I need to turn in the signed liability waivers for my group?

All volunteers **MUST** turn in their signed liability waivers to receive supplies and shirts. If you do not have all liability waivers signed, you will be asked to come back once they are signed. The amount of supplies we provide will match the number of waivers submitted.
